Electricity Consumption

<u>EIA</u> forecasts that U.S. electricity consumption will decrease by 3.6% in 2020, including a decrease of 6.4% in the commercial sector and 8.8% in the industrial sector. Electricity consumption in 2021 is expected to remain at similar levels.


Renewable Energy

The U.S. continues to see an increase in electricity generation from renewable energy sources. Electricity generation from renewables increased from 17% in 2019 to 20% in 2020 and is expected to grow as much as 22% in 2021. This is largely due to the addition of wind and solar generating capacity.

Natural Gas Prices

The Henry Hub natural gas spot price averaged \$2.39 per MMBtu in October, up from September's average of \$1.92/MMBtu. Looking ahead to 2021, the EIA forecasts monthly average prices to remain above \$3.00/MMBtu throughout next year, averaging \$3.14/MMBtu.

Natural Gas Production/Storage Levels

EIA reports indicate natural gas storage in the U.S. reached 4.0 Tcf in October, 5% more than the five year average. By the end of the 2020 heating season, they expect storage levels to drop to 1.5 Tcf by March 2021, 16% lower than the five year average. Low levels of U.S. natural gas production are driving the expected drop.
